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Schools are becoming the arena of transformation, the foundation for shaping informed, engaged citizens. In the face of growing uncertainty and complex challenges, schools play a special role: they build the resilience of local communities, shape democratic competences and support the mental health of the young generation. The conference will address the need to transform schools in three complementary dimensions:

I. SCHOOL AS A HEALTHY BUILDING

A school understood as a healthy, energy-efficient and self-sufficient facility supporting the physical and mental well-being of students, and at the same time ready to act as a shelter in crisis situations. In the focus: air quality, energy efficiency, indoor climate - thermal and acoustic comfort, adaptation to climate change and multifunctionality of educational spaces.

II. SCHOOL AS THE HEART OF THE URBAN COMMUNITY

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A school, as a key element of local infrastructure, is becoming an arena for social transformation and an open and safe common space serving the entire local community. Its surroundings, appropriately designed and adapted to changing environmental conditions, providing a green and safe **buffer zone** - protecting against air pollution, noise, excessive car traffic, heat and other effects of climate change. The ongoing spatial planning 'revolution' in Poland might be a perfect opportunity to address those challenges.

III. SCHOOL AS A MECCA OF DEMOCRACY

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A school is a space where children and young people can really experience democracy in action. This type of approach strengthens civic, ecological and spatial awareness, and above all teaches co-responsibility. Drawing from Nordic experiences, we aim to develop democratic citizen science when it comes to urban planning.


